

Disaster Relief Extended Overview

An extension of our classic Public Sector (Disaster Relief) scenario, Public Sector extended integrates the concept of Logistics in the form of Stock Transfer Planning. Applicable to public sector organizations, universities, hospitals, and defense organizations, this scenario is available as a half-day or full-day session.






Storms/disaster moves from SYDNEY to BRISBANE to TOWNSVILLE.

Disaster Relief Extended Processes

The overall **objective** of Public Sector Extended is to gain **social sentiment** -- a success score representing how accurate and timely your team meets the three communities need for relief products and services as they survive a natural disaster.

The four roles include:

- Budget Officer: Responsible for managing the disaster relief budget and funds
- Procurement Officer: Responsible for maintaining inventory of products and services
- **Transport Officer**: Responsible for moving products from the central storage location to regional storage locations as well as inter-regionally.
- Allocation Officer: Responsible for distributing products and services to the three stricken areas.
